

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Friday 31 st July 2020	
Activity Title: Eid Potato Printing	
Learning Intention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learns that they have similarities and differences that connect them to, and distinguish them from, others. 	Activity Overview: Create celebration cards for Eid by potato printing star and moon shapes.
Links to EYFS: Understanding the World: People and Communities: 22-36 months	
Resources: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Potatoes carved into stars and moon shapes Card Paint Glue Sequins Glitter 	Key vocabulary: Card, print, moon, star, press, stamp, colour, choose, where, Eid, celebrate, Muslim, Islam, Hajj, pilgrimage, fasting, lamb.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk briefly about Eid and why it is celebrated. Explain to your child that they can make a card to celebrate this festival. 	
Main Activity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set out a range of colourful paints with the carved potatoes and card folded in half. Encourage your child to decorate their card with the available resources. You could add glue to the paint so that the sequins and glitter stick well. 	
Activity Review <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Who will you give your card to? Do you celebrate Eid? What kind of celebrations do you have? Do any of your friends and family celebrate Eid? What do they do to celebrate? 	
Additional ways to support your child: You could try sticking a fork in the top of the potato if your child is finding it difficult to pick up and hold the potato.	Extension: Find a suitable story about Eid online to read or watch. Talk with your child about what happens in the story.
