

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: 13th July 2020

Activity Title: Goldilocks and the three bears - Stick Puppets

Learning Intention:

Making stick puppets is an easy activity that gets kids thinking creatively!

Links to EYFS:

Expressive art and design

Physical Development

Activity Overview:

The child will be able to relate what each character looks like to them.

Resources:

- Twinkl worksheet
- 2 craft sticks
- Scissors
- Glue

Key vocabulary:

Chat, store, collect, prepare, necessity

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)

Introduction:

- Invite your child to assemble the puppets and play with them while you tell the fable about the ant and the grasshopper

Main Activity:

- Print out our templates - print out the characters template. The puppets were designed to be glued onto craft sticks.
- Glue each of the character's body onto a craft stick. Position the shape near the tip of the stick. If you're using jumbo craft sticks, the top edge of the shape should be about an inch from the tip of the stick. That's it! Enjoy 😊
- It's always fun to ask a children if they know what a word means. You might get a great answer! Also, you can find out what a child knows.
- Along with vocabulary, your child can also learn an important life lesson. The moral of this one is: Be nice and kind, and look after property!



Additional ways to support your child:

- Encourage your child to use the puppets and either retell the story or create own one.

Extension:

- Imagine one other insect that would like to meet the ant and grasshopper. Create your own puppet to add to the story.
