


# Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Wednesday 08 <sup>th</sup> July 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> Role Play - Birthday	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Demonstrates friendly behaviour, initiating conversations and forming good relationships with peers and familiar adults.</li> <li>- Count object to ten, and beginning to count beyond 10.</li> </ul>	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Ask children open questions to develop language. Be creative and use props to support play.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Personal, Social and Emotional Development</li> <li>• Mathematics</li> </ul>	
<b>Resources:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Party hats, plates, cups etc.</li> <li>- Teddy or any soft toy</li> <li>- Toy cake, cake drawing... or constructed birthday cake made with box modelling.</li> </ul>	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Numbers 1 to 10, and beyond.
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)</b>	
<b>Introduction</b> -Set up the resources indoors or outdoors and explain your child what game you are going to play and how.	
<b>Activity:</b> -With your child, talk about that the teddy is going to have a birthday and to guess how old he is. -Set up a party using the plates and other items, counting out as you lay the table. -Use pretend candles (made from play dough or paper) and sing ‘Happy Birthday’ to teddy and encourage your child to count the candles. -Count out pretend party food and accessories.	
	
<b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> -Ensure the children are using correct pronunciation of numbers -Could be extended to count and sort other party objects	<b>Extension:</b> -Encourage predicting, how many candles will we need for teddy?
