

# Individual Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Monday 27 <sup>th</sup> July 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> Rainbow Fish Collage	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> Distinguishes between the marks they make	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Making a collage of the 'Rainbow Fish.'
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> Literacy	
<b>Resources :</b> Card (old cereal boxes, cardboard box or any sturdy material made from card) Lolly pop stick (use a pencil or straw if you don't have any) A variety of collage materials (tissue paper, sequins, glitter etc. Glue/Pritt Stick	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Fish, colours, make, create, collage, patterns, stick, glue,
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)</b>	
<p><b>Introduction:</b> Show your child all the resources that they will be using today Give them the opportunity to hold ,feel, describe and compare the different collage materials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What have you found that is exciting?</li> <li>• Is there any other material that are similar?</li> <li>• Can you tell me about what you have picked up?</li> </ul> <p><b>Main Activity:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explain to your child that they will be creating a rainbow fish collage using the variety of different materials</li> <li>• Let your child explore the different materials and then encourage them to choose what they would like to glue onto the template</li> <li>• Encourage your child to think about the colours and patterns that they are making or creating</li> <li>• Role model the activity by collaging your own fish at the same time...</li> <li>• <i>"I am going to use these buttons to decorate my fish. First I will use a big one then a small one. I am going to repeat this again by sticking down another big button and then a small one..."</i></li> <li>• Use this opportunity to ask questions</li> <li>• What button do you think goes next?</li> <li>• I wonder what piece you will use next</li> <li>• Can you tell me what you are doing?</li> <li>• Can you describe to me what materials you are using?</li> <li>• What colours do you see?</li> <li>• When your child has finished let the collage dry</li> <li>• Attach a lollipop stick/straw or whatever you have available to the template with your child to resemble a flag</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Challenge:</b> Encourage your child to make a repeated pattern on another fish template. You can use more material or some paint. Role model the activity beforehand</p>	
<b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> Encourage your child to free collage the fish as they choose. Talk about and describe the different materials you have chosen together	<b>Extension:</b> Use a variety of different pictures of fish for your child to see. Encourage them to select one and copy the pattern using the materials they have in front of them
