


# Individual Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Thursday 16 <sup>th</sup> July 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> Seagull Lunch	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> Shows care and concern for living things and the environment.	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Your child will create a sandwich for the seagulls.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> Shows care and concern for living things and the environment	
<b>Equipment:</b> Link to story <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=46wCRq50Wwg">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=46wCRq50Wwg</a> Sandwich template attached. Colouring pencils or crayons.	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Food research, seagulls, sandwich, filling.
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)</b>	
<b>Introduction:</b> Listen to the story The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch. Ask your child the following questions <u>Where is the story set?</u> <u>Who are the characters?</u> <u>What do the seagulls do?</u> <u>Why do you think they did this?</u> <u>What happens to them in the end?</u> <u>How do you think you can stop the seagulls from stealing the food?</u> <b>Main Activity:</b> Explain to your child that they are going to surprise the seagulls with a special sandwich just for them First you need to do some research . <u>What do seagulls like to eat?</u> Read through the facts at the bottom of the lesson plan. Now decide what you are going to put into the Seagull sandwich. Draw your sandwich using the template. <b>Challenge:</b> In the story the Seagulls devoured the sandwiches. <u>What do you think this word means?</u> <u>Can you think of any other words to describe how people eat food?</u>	
<b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> Help your child to write a list of the fillings they drew for the Seagull sandwich.	<b>Extension:</b> Ask your child to recap on what they would put in the seagull sandwich. Can they write it down for Mrs Grinling?
