



Activity Lesson Plan

The Parcel

Date: Monday 6 th July	
Activity Title: Role Play – Tea Party	
Learning Intention: Says some counting words randomly Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10	Activity Overview: Ask the children open questions to develop language. Ensure the children are using correct pronunciation of numbers.
Links to EYFS: Mathematics	Key vocabulary: Numbers 1 to 10, and beyond, more, less, add one more...
Resources: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indoors or outdoors • Picnic blanket, cups, plates, play food etc. 	
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Let your child know that you are going to set up a tea party, like the one the chimps have in the story ‘The Parcel.’ 	
Main Activity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Set up a tea party using the plates and other items, counting out as you lay them out. - Encourage your child to repeat the numbers after you. - Ask your child questions as they set up, how many plates we will need etc... - Count out play food and accessories for everyone involved. - Share out the food, counting how many you need. 	 
Challenge: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Firstly test your child to see if they can count by rote, ‘1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10’ - Now can your child count accurately, pointing to one object at a time whilst saying one number. Encourage the use of their counting finger. 	
Additional ways to support your child: -Fully participate in this ongoing to ensure the children see how fun and enjoyable it can be. As your child becomes more confident, he/she will need less support in sharing out the items.	Extension: -Could be extended to count and sort other resources for the picnic -Encourage predicting, how many plates will we need if teddy joins for the picnic?
